

WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

I am Alfred Napahuelua Spinney, Kanaka-Hawaiian subject and Prime Minister for the government of the Kingdom of the Hawaiian Islands; I am the next of kin and the next friend to David Kaawa V, Tatianna Kaawa and Kainalu Kaawa, all Kanaka-Hawaiian subjects and keiki o ka aina Kingdom of the Hawaiian Islands. I appear at this court specially for the purpose of presenting this WRIT in aid of our children and their best interest, especially their liberty.

In my capacity above identified I claim the bodies of David Kaawa V, Tatianna Kaawa and Kainalu Kaawa. I present this WRIT and thereby require the immediate release of David Kaawa V, Tatianna Kaawa and Kainalu Kaawa from the unlawful, arbitrary and continuing detention by State of Hawaii and other persons including Lloyd Van de Car, Susan Mc Cree, Stephanie St. John, Catholic Charities Hawaii, Barbara Fields and other persons whose name are unknown at this time.

Our children are unlawfully detained by the above named persons. We charge that the removal of our Hawaiian children from our country into the United States is GENOCIDE as defined by the International Declaration of Human Rights and by the USC Title 18 Section 1091 (6). The Kaawa children David, Tatianna and Kainalu are detained by State of Hawaii Department of Human Services under the pretense that they are being protected from their father David Kaawa IV.

David Kaawa IV the father of the children is not now nor has he ever been accused of or charged with harming his children. The children have been unlawfully and arbitrarily detained for over one (1) year.

The Office of the Attorney General for the government of the Hawaiian Kingdom has investigated this case and it concludes that Susan Mc Cree and Lloyd Van de Car are engaging in a conspiracy to alienate the Kaawa children from their father, their family, the country of their birth, their culture and their ethnicity.

We charge that these acts by Susan Mc Cree and Lloyd Van de Car are committed under color of law and color of authority are willful and malicious and constitute GENOCIDE against the Hawaiian people a distinct racial cultural and ethnic group of people of the Kingdom of the Hawaiian islands.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons the LAWS require this court to immediately require State of Hawaii to bring our children David Kaawa V, Tatianna Kaawa and Kainalu Kaawa before this court to release our children from their unlawful and continuing detention.
